Parents/Carers will make every effort to:

Support the aims of the school.

Ensure their child attends regularly and on time.

Ensure their child wears the school uniform and follows the school dress code.

Ensure that they and their child follow the school's Code of Conduct and the Acceptable Use Code of Conduct policy.

Support the school's behaviour policy and co-operate fully with any behaviour procedures should they become necessary.

Attend any parent consultations, reviews, assemblies or events which involve their child.

Ensure their child completes any homework and returns it on time.

Read regularly with their children i.e. at least 3 times a week.

Keep the school informed of any changes in circumstances (i.e. address, phone number, emergency contacts etc.)

Inform the school of any problems that may affect their child's learning or behaviour.
