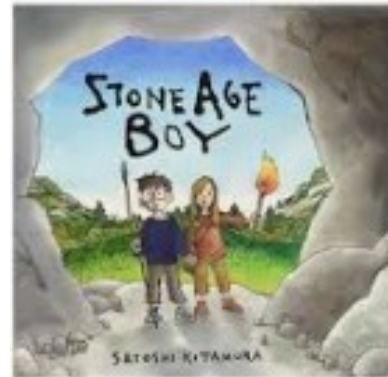
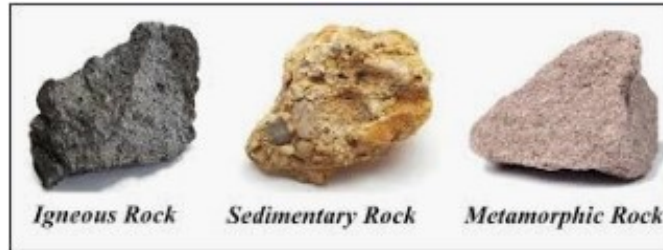




Engagement Plan: Year 3 Autumn 1 Stone Age to Iron age

National Curriculum

In English we will be reading *Stone Age Boy* by Satoshi Kitamura and will be writing a narrative. We will focus on improving our sentence structure and making our writing more interesting by using a variety of adjectives and adverbs. We will begin to learn the Year 3 spelling rules. We will work hard to improve our reading fluency by reading aloud both with a partner and with an adult.

In Maths, we will begin the term by revisiting place value so that the children have a secure understanding of it. We will continue to use Tackling Tables to improve our fluency.

In science, we will be learning about rocks and their properties. We will learn how to identify the three main types of rock.

In ICT we will be using 'Scratch' which is a visual language programme.

In RE we will be studying the Saints of God.
