

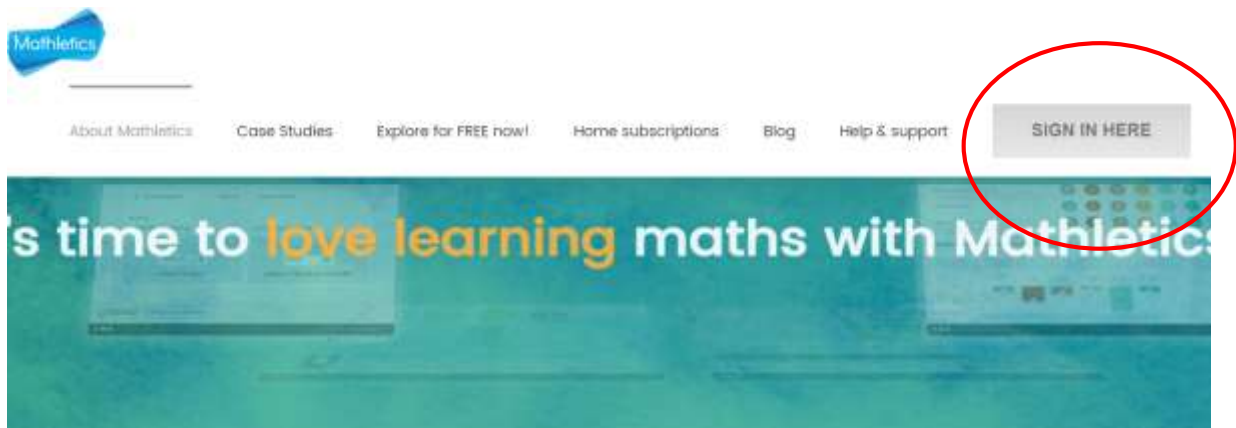
Maths homework is now being set on Mathletics. The homework will be set weekly and children have been given their own username and password to access this.

If your child does not have access to the internet at home then there are a range of options available. Within school, a Mathletics club is offered on a Thursday lunchtime and computer and Ipad clubs are offered on different days. In addition to this, your child could attend Brain stretchers after school.

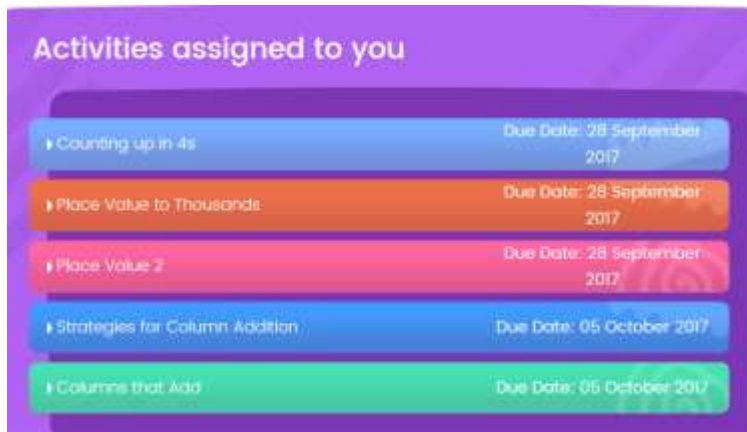
Signing in:



Your child will have been given their log in details. Please notify your class teacher if for any reason you have not got log in details.

## Completing homework:



Your child will be 'locked out' from all other mathematics games, including live mathematics, until their homework is complete.

Assigned homework is viewable as soon as your child logs in.



Enter answers using the keyboard on screen or your normal keyboard.

Clicking the 'i' button on the right of the screen brings up a video to support your child if stuck.

Once homework is completed, the class teacher is automatically notified of the results.

Homework is usually set on a Friday, and needs completing before the next week's homework is set. Teachers can track who is not accessing their homework.
