Dear Parents and Carers

You may well remember recently completing one of our school questionnaires. I would like to thank each one of you who did so, giving us some feedback. This year we had slightly less responses than last but we are still able to look at your individual concerns and then draw conclusions from your responses.

In all areas there was never more than 6% of parents who answered either disagree or strongly disagree.

More of you feel that your child is happy in school, making good progress and being suitably challenged. Also you are much happier about homework this year and recognise that we have a wide range of activities, trips and visits planned into the curriculum for our children.

When we consider organisation more of you are feeling that the school is well managed and welcoming to all and communication is slightly improved as well. There are still some who feel that concerns are not dealt with as well as they could be and, whilst striving to improve, I would ask that you come and see a member of the leadership team to make an appointment to discuss your own experiences further.

We have noticed that less of you feel that we are encouraging a healthy lifestyle and this does concern us. We will discuss this with our senior leadership team and see if we can find some healthier rewards for our children. Also we have seen that your confidence in our children's behaviour is not as strong as it was and again we will look at our records of incidents to see why this may be and what we can do to improve things.
