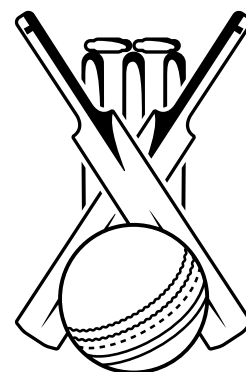
Year 5/6 Whittlesey Schools Quick Sticks Hockey Tournament
