2nd Place = Manor Mallards

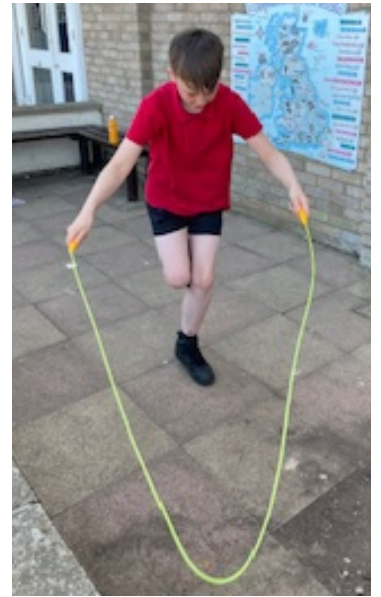
3rd Place = Fenland Finches
