National Curriculum

In English, our writing focus will be to entertain. We will be using the 'boxing up' method to create a story linked to Ancient Egypt. We will continue to work on find and retrieve questions in reading as well as inference questions.

In history, we will be learning about all aspects of Egyptian life, from the very rich to the very poor. We will have the opportunity to use role play to learn about the process of mummification.

In Maths, we will continue to look for the most efficient method of calculating an answer. We will begin to use the short multiplication method. Times tables will still be a focus (particularly rapid recall of 4 and 8 times)

In science, we will be learning about humans and animals, focussing on movement, joints and diet.

In RE we will learn about the Muslim way of praying and will hopefully visit the mosque.
